1. Julie invited her friend Lisa to the movies. Each ticket costs \$6. Julie had \$20. How much change did Julie receive?
2. Sara baked cookies for her friends. She baked 30 cookies. She shared them equally among herself and 3 friends. How many cookies did each friend receive? Were there any left over?
3. Jim has to read a book for a book report. On Monday he read 35 pages. On Tuesday he read 102 pages. On Wednesday he read 77 pages. The book has 301 pages. How many more pages does Jim have to read?
4. Kyle has a rock collection. He keeps the rocks in 7 boxes. Each box has 4 rocks in it. How many rocks does Kyle have?
5. Sandra has 3 boxes of chocolate. Each box has 9 chocolates in it. She wants to share all the chocolates equally with herself and 4 friends. How many chocolates will each friend receive? Will there be any left over?
